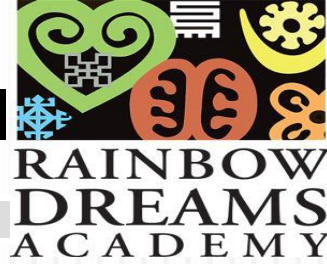

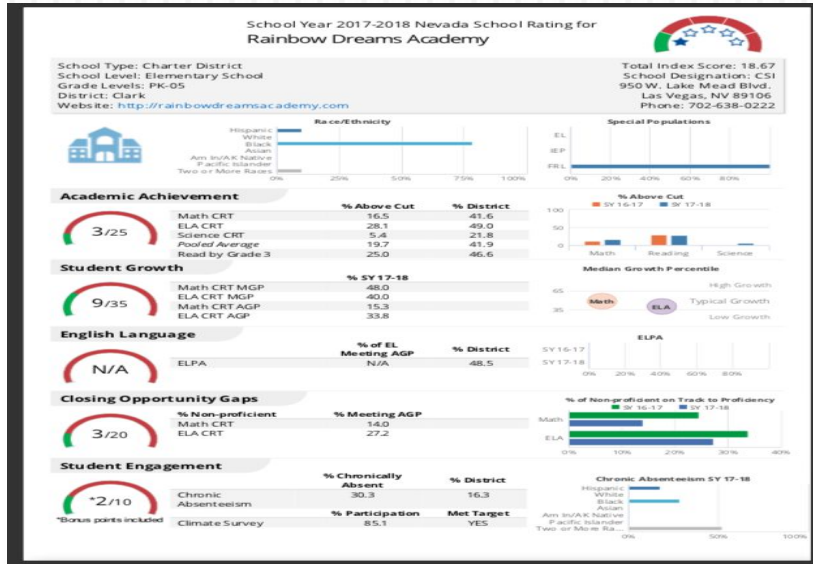

Rainbow Dreams Academy Elementary School

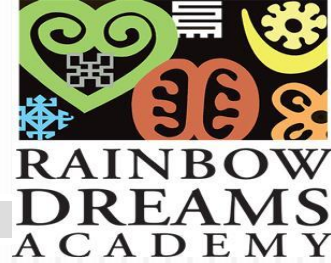

What does my school rating mean?

One-Star school: Identifies a school that has **not met** the state's standard for performance. Students and subgroups are inconsistent in achieving performance standards. A one-star school has in multiple areas that require improvement including an urgent need to address areas that are significantly below standard. The school must submit an improvement plan that identifies supports tailored to subgroups and indicators that are below standard. The school is subject to state interventions.

How are school star ratings determined?
 Schools receive points based on student performance across various indicators and indicators. These points are added and divided by the points possible to produce an index score from 1-100. This index score is associated with a one-to-five star school rating.

How are star ratings determined based on total index score?

- Below 29: ★
- At or above 29 but less than 50: ★★
- At or above 50 and less than 70: ★★★
- At or above 70 and less than 80: ★★★★
- At or above 80: ★★★★★
